**Footnotes**

UNCLE MOMO broke on top and quickly moved clear to set the pace inside up the backstretch, abruptly came out a path entering the turn, faced mild pressure and some coaxing past the five-sixteenths pole, drifted out a bit despite right-handed use of the whip in upper- to mid-stretch, was given steady urging to the wire and held sway. CAVALRY CHARGE was coaxed forward at the start, obtained forward position stalking the leader going three wide on the turn, edged closer under encouragement out of that bend, was hard-driven in the lane but couldn't get past while just saving the place from. SYMPHONIC, who bumped the inside rival at the start, recovered and moved forward while shifting in to track the leaders along the rail through the turn, began to come out leaving that bend coming in the four path past the quarter pole then angled out a further two paths near the three-sixteenths, took aim and was gaining late. STEADYTILLREADY broke outwardly just a bit, was in good position outside runners pursuing the leader, went four wide through the turn coming five wide past the quarter pole and still in range but weakened inside the final furlong. GREENBACK was bumped at the break and consequently lost his path in the early going relegated toward the rear along the inside, saved ground through the turn advancing inside rivals and ran on evenly in the stretch. HURRICANE DANCER was in good position tracking behind the leaders from off the inside up the backstretch into the turn going in the three to four path on that bend, came out five to six wide into upper stretch and failed to rally. DONTNEEDANAME broke a half-step slowly, raced wide on the turn going in the four to five path and coming out seven deep past the quarter pole, was never near enough to threaten. TORNADO BOY raced between runners in the back half early, went in the three path through the turn coming out a path leaving that bend and failed to produce a bid. KINGSTON STREET was outside rivals early toward the back, went five wide into the turn moving in a path on that bend and came up empty.
