GIO CARE took the rail position around the first turn then settled nicely while tracking the early leader, prompted to pick up the pace going by the half mile marker then coaxed along the outside around the far turn, kept on determinedly for the leader in the stretch run, collared foe in late stages and finished clear under a driving finish. BEAR ALLEY took the lead and angled inside heading into the first turn, set the pace and pulled on top while racing under slight restraint, held firm over challenger's around the far turn then dug in for more near inside in stretch run, kept on with effort but could not hold off GIO CARE in final stages. DON BOURBON raced in range positioned just off the second flight early on, headed in pursuit for the leader around the far turn, raced in close range near the quarter pole then failed to advance with the top pair but pushed on and finished well clear over the rest. OBIWAN raced along the rail and steadied upon entering the first turn, raced off the pace two to three wide and ridden along to pick up the tempo entering the turn, failed to advance then dropped to the inside near the quarter pole and offered no late bid. SILVER MAKER was reserved four wide down the backstretch and had no response when called upon. RIVER STONES stalked the pace racing a path outside eventual winner the came up empty entering the far turn.
