QUICK STEP ED raced in contention while forwardly placed in the opening quarter, edged a bit closer then remained patiently handled around the turn, shifted out wider for the drive then given cue, responded and drew clear late. CELTIC BROTHERHOOD moved up the inside and cleared on top shortly after the start, continued to set the pace by a clear advantage, held off the challenge of FREEDOM FORCE near the quarter pole, pushed on with a slim lead over foe at the furlong marker then held firm over rival but got outkicked when the winner drew by late. FREEDOM FORCE was away in good order and forwardly placed then prompted to go after the leader nearing the quarter pole, continued a bid in striking distance near the furlong grounds then evened out in the final sixteenth. SHAW raced in range while saving ground through early stages, angled out on the turn, raced six wide under a drive entering the lane and continued a mild bid. VIPER had no early speed and lagged behind then raced wide into the lane and passed tiring foes. W W CANDY raced off the pace then saved ground around the turn and failed to move into contention. WEST SIDE WARRIOR hustled up from the get-go, chased three to four wide and lacked the needed response for impact. DISTURBIN BOURBON chased two wide not far back in opening quarter then gave way on the turn.
