Footnotes

PICASSO showed good speed, contested the pace on the inside of a foe, vied along the rail on the turn, shook clear when asked into upper stretch, extended the advantage under a solid hand ride into the final furlong and maintained a safe advantage while ridden out. MAJOR ATTRACTION broke a half-step slow then bumped with a foe shortly after the start, steadied between horses at the five-eighths then moved out, settled outside under some urging, was ridden along while four wide on the turn, came six wide into the stretch then passed foes on the outside, drifted in a bit around the sixteenth-pole and finished willingly for the place. CAVALRY CHARGE was hustled from the start, pressed the pace between horses, dropped back leaving the backstretch, chased three wide on the turn, swung five wide into the stretch, raced between horses under a drive inside the three-sixteenths, drifted in a bit outside the sixteenth-pole and finished with good courage but missed the place while clear for the show. FAIRWAY MAGIC was off slow and spotted the front a couple of lengths, moved in midway down the backstretch, went two to three wide on the turn and failed to rally. STEADYTILLREADY bumped soundly with a rival at the start, was urged along between horses then dropped back midway down the backstretch, saved ground on the turn, steadied some behind a rival inside the three-sixteenths and came up empty. DON'T RECALL bumped soundly with a foe at the start then bumped with another opponent shortly thereafter and was taken up, dropped well behind, rounded the turn in the two path, came three wide into the stretch, moved out near the sixteenth-pole and failed to threaten. SYMPHONIC disputed the pace between horses, was ridden along in the two path on the turn, dropped back into upper stretch and capitulated. KEEN SAMURAI broke a half-step slow, disputed the pace on the outside of multiple foes, vied four then three wide on the turn, dropped back into upper stretch and faded.
