Footnotes

FOLLOW THE FLAG stalked along the inside to the far turn, remained forwardly placed then cut the corner and moved up to challenge for the lead, vied inside of LET THEM EAT CAKE then inched away and held on over moving up MAKISUPA. MAKISUPA (GB) was forwardly placed through early stages, hustled up and raced two wide between foes at the quarter pole, sustained a bid along the outside in stretch run and was edging up on the winner in final strides. LET THEM EAT CAKE led the way around the first turn and set the pace down the backstretch, held firm around the far turn then took on the

challenge from rail running winner, vied two wide then lacked a closing kick in reserve. RENATA settled off the early pace and saved ground, was not too far back along the rail on the far turn, cut the corner then lacked the needed response for late impact. BRIGHT STREET raced off the pace then hustled up on the far turn, raced six wide under pressure upper stretch and passed tiring rivals. ROYAL MANDATE raced off the pace then urged three wide entering the far turn, floated out wide entering the drive and lacked a needed rally. TWO CENT TOOTSIE raced in range to the far turn, launched a bid and remained a strong contender around the far turn then gave way in the lane. OCALA rated in good position down the backstretch then had no response when called upon. MARIPOSA BELLE raced off the pace and saved ground, came off the inside and hustled along but could not muster a rally. FIRST IN COMMAND got bumped just after the start, raced off the pace and offered no late bid. BETTER WITH AGE bumped with foe out of the gate and lost momentum and failed to move into close range. SUNDAE SMILE got bumped a bit at the start and raced in the back throughout.
