Footnotes

OUR LAST BUCK away without apparent mishap, attained a forward position, was rated in the two path showing the way, shadowed by the runner up, himself one path farther off the rail, continued onward under the same set up all the way to the end of the bend, got driven three wide into the lane, rapidly extended the margin after CHESTERTOWN swerved out sharply in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, then maintained that advantage the rest of the trip home. CHESTERTOWN in the three path contending for the top against the winner, was being tipped wider getting cued up for the stretch run, ducked out several paths in the vicinity of three-sixteenths pole, resulting in the top one lengthening away, chased that opponent futilely thereafter, had no difficulty salvaging second. DANNY CALIFORNIA pinched at the start, went over to the rail, secured the show off the ground-saving journey that followed. RUN FOR BOSTON sent over to the rail approaching the conclusion of the backstretch, cut the corner into the stretch, made no headway. KID D'ORO chased the pace from the three path in midpack, swung slightly wider into the lane, lacked the needed response. YANKEE DIVISION strung out three wide on the turn, folded. BEG TO DIFFER parked out four wide on the turn, gave way.
