An auspicious debut by the \$1.4 million yearling **4 BELIEVE NOW** stamps the second-start 3yo the one to beat stretching to a route in just his second start. His fourth-place sprint debut was super. He was hard-held while racing sixth in traffic, angled out for room in the stretch, finished well and galloped out big. 'NOW posted a series of sharp recent works; the 3yo Uncle Mo colt looks like a good one. **2 DIVINE ARMOR**, also a 3yo, has something the top choice lacks. That is, experience around two turns. 'ARMOR added blinkers last out and ran the best race of his four-start career, an 89-Beyer runner-up finish while nearly five lengths clear of third. That was three months ago, prior to the interruption of racing. If 'ARMOR runs two alike, the top choice will have a fight on his hands. **3 MURALIST** is a 4-year-old who has gradually improved each successive start. Runner-up three of five, he will be rolling late.
