STAKES Ohio Derby Grade 3 - Thoroughbred

FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS. No Nomination Fee by Wednesday June 17, 2020. Supplementary Nominations accepted to the Ohio Derby of \$1,250 are due by Saturday June 20, 2020. \$600 to enter and \$550 additional to Start, with a purse of \$500,000, of which 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth, and 2% to sixth. Weights: 126 lbs. Non-Winners of a Grade 1 Stake at a mile or over allowed 2 lbs., Non-Winners of a Grade 2 Stake at a mile or over allowed 4 lbs., of \$60,000 at a mile or over since December 27, 2019 allowed 6 lbs. (Maiden, Claiming, Optional, and Starter races are not considered in weight allowances). The Ohio Derby will be limited to Fourteen (14) Starters. In the event more than Fourteen (14) Entries pass through the entry box by the usual time of closing on Tuesday June 23, 2020. Preference will be given to (1) Grade/Group 1 winners, (2) Grade/Group 2 winners and Grade/Group 1 place finishers, (3) Grade/Group 3 winners and Grade/Group 2 place finishers, (4) Highest Lifetime Earnings. Lifetime Earnings will be determined according to statistics provided by Equibase. A Trophy is presented to the winning Owner, Trainer and Jockey.



**Footnotes**

DEAN MARTINI broke alertly and battled for the lead along the rail into the clubhouse turn, dropped back a bit, came back through the inside after a half, set the balance of the pace, shook clear in upper stretch and lasted under right handed urging. SOUTH BEND unhurried for six furlongs, closed steadily outside rivals, surged five wide through the final furlong and was steadily cutting into the winners' advantage late while clear for second. STORM THE COURT vied

for the lead four then three wide the entire trip and finished with good courage. ROWDY YATES contested the lead two wide through the clubhouse turn, maintained strong pressure while saving ground into the stretch then finished evenly. SPRAWL broke outward, was allowed to settle, offered a mild bid in the four path into the stretch then leveled off. LEBDA battled for the lead three then two wide into the second turn then gradually weakened. ROGUE ELEMENT trailed through the far turn then passed tiring rivals. UNRIGHTEOUS with the second flight four wide, failed to offer the needed response. INFORMATIVE broke a step slow and was no factor. BEAR ALLEY was brushed at the start then through after a half. CODE RUNNER broke inward brushing BEAR ALLEY and was outrun. ESTABLISHED vied for the lead three wide and was through after a half. DACK JANIEL'S with the second flight three wide for four and one half furlongs flattened out.
