

**Analysis By: Mike Beer****Best Bet: Figure of Speech (3rd race)**

6 **MYSTIC GUIDE** raced very greenly but showed plenty of potential in his sprint debut, then stretched right out around two turns and impressively broke his maiden in his next start; good try last time but he had no chance with the razor-sharp Tap It to Win on the front end; bred to get this trip and he appears to have as much upside as anyone in this field. 2 **COUNTRY GRAMMER** was narrowly outfinished for 2nd by MYSTIC GUIDE in that allowance race last time and he likely needed that one following three months on the sidelines; keeps getting better and this distance is well within his scope. 8 **CHESTERTOWN** a \$2 million NY-bred who has always wanted distance and who has been brought along slowly by Asmussen; ran well in that narrow defeat over this distance at Fair Grounds in February, before getting lost in the Louisiana Derby; blinkers on after nearly bolting while chasing a front-running winner last time.
