GREYES CREEK raced back early on, was in the four path into the lane, began a rally in the upper stretch, was carried out a bit by drifting out foe while flying down the lane and drove past the leader in the final stages. MY AMERICA set the pace early, was on the inside into the lane, drew clear in the stretch but was ran down in the late stages. MANTRA chased the pace early, was off the rail into the lane, altered out once in the stretch, began a rally, drifted out and was gaining in the final stages. ANDESITE stalked the pace early, was in the three path into the lane, made a bid in the stretch and finished willingly in the late stages. ELUSIVE RULER stalked the pace early, was on the inside into the lane and finished willingly in the late stages. CAVALRY CHARGE raced back early on, was in the five path into the lane with a mild gain in the stretch run. LAKE NAKURU was in the six path into the lane and improved position. ATTORNEY TIM was never a threat. BEE CATCHER was never a factor. EL AHIJADO tracked the pace early, was off the rail into the lane and faded in the

stretch drive. SEA OF HOPE chased the pace from the outside early on, was in the three path into the lane, bothered in the upper stretch and empty late in the drive. SCABBARD was through after a half.
