STAKES Peter Pan S. Grade 3 - Thoroughbred

FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$100 each which should accompany the nomination; \$750 to pass the entry box and an additional \$750 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$1,500 along with the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 55% to the winner, 20% to second, 12% to third, 6% to fourth, 4% to fifth and 3% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. The Peter Pan has been selected as one the races in the Kentucky Derby Championship Series. The winner of the Peter Pan will be awarded 50 points, the second place finisher 20 points, the third place finisher 10 points and the fourth place finisher 5 points. Weight 123 lbs. Non-winners of a graded sweepstake at a mile or over in 2020 allowed 3 lbs.; of a sweepstake other than state-bred at a mile or over or three races other than maiden, claiming, starter or state-bred allowance allowed 5 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, July 4, 2020 with 32 Nominations.

COUNTRY GRAMMER away in good order, got set up in the pocket before leaving the homestretch, rated well keeping an eye on the front runners contending for the top a short distance up ahead, inched up after three-quarters had been reeled, gained usable passage along the inside corridor past the five-sixteenths pole, availed for the opportunity provided, moving up and then cutting the corner into the lane with good momentum, whittled away at the deficit during the ensuing furlong, enough so as to begin the last eighth on near terns with CARACARO, raced directly abreast of that opponent thereafter, assumed the slimmest of leads when the twosome made contact with under a sixteenth remaining, then stayed on well enough long enough to cross the wire first. CARACARO gently pinched in the shadow of the starting gate, powered his way forward, proceeded along the two path on the first turn, was swung out three wide entering the backstretch, left the half mile pole from the same one, made his presence felt around the far turn, arrived into the stretch and challenged in earnest, emerged at the furlong marker in front, albeit barely, went at it eye to eye with the winner from that juncture onward, fell back by a sliver after bumping with the top one in deep stretch, ventured onward, but had to settle for second. MYSTIC GUIDE brushed at the start, sat reserved two wide for over three-quarters, fanned out into path four from upper to midlane, rallied for the show. CELTIC STRIKER attained a forward position after

bobbling at the start, attended the pacesetter two to three wide, got asked for more after going six furlongs, stepped into the lane approximately two wide, backed away. MODERNIST saved ground until the quarter pole, was urged into the two path for entrance into the stretch, made no impact. CHESTERTOWN pinched at the start, took up the chase two wide in midpack, commenced the stretch one path wider, gave way. CANDY TYCOON stumbled in an awkward manner after springing from the gate, tucked along the rail and went on to save ground to no avail. MO HAWK argued for control from along the inside, well rated in the early stages, drifted a bit towards the two path in the first stages of a retreat in the general area of the five-sixteenths pole, made it to the head of the stretch appearing to have little left and faded. KATZARELLI brushed at the start, raced three wide on both turns and folded.
