Just taking a guess with **5 RAPID RESPONSE**, a gelding by 18% juvenile debut stallion Great Notion. The dam won sprinting and the second dam was a stakes-placed dirt sprinter. Figures to be a big price in a wide-open baby race. **2 SPEIGHTSTER RED**(\$85,000 short yearling, \$135,000 yearling RNA) is by a promising first-crop sire that is 5 for 25 with debut runners. Half-brother to stakes-placed dirt router Holiday's Jewel. Second dam is multiple Grade 3 winner Tricky Squaw. **9 LAMARKABLE** (\$70,000 yearling RNA) is out of juvenile stakes-winning synthetic sprinter Dr. Diamonds Prize and is a half-brother to two juvenile winners. Solid-looking work tab for always-dangerous barn. KING ALAN (\$11,000 yearling) stumbled badly at the start, then was forced to play catch-up in promising debut. Up from the maiden claiming ranks. JAXON TRAVELER (\$80,000 yearling, \$140,000 June juvenile) breezed a furlong in 10 flat prior to the most recent auction and is out of stakes-placed dirt miler Listen Boy. Barn having a fantastic year with 2-year-olds. IRON PEARLS (\$25,000 yearling, \$30,000 June juvenile) is a half-brother to Grade 3-placed turf router Benergy. SOME MO is a full brother to multiple Grade 3-winning turf router Ultra Brat and is a half to Grade 3-winning turf router It's Tea Time and stakes-placed turf router Shootin the Breeze. INDEFATIGABLE (\$135,000 yearling RNA, \$120,000 June juvenile) is a half-brother to multiple stakes-winning dirt sprinter Seeking the Sheriff.
