OUTADORE stalked the pace early, was in the five path into the lane, drove past the leaders three wide in the stretch and drew clear under a steady drive. FAUCI chased the pace early, was in the three path into the lane, altered out in the upper stretch, made a bid but had no gain on the winner in the final stages. COWAN was bumped at the start and raced back early on, was in the five path into the lane with some gain in the late stages. COUNTY FINAL came out at the start, set the pace early, was off the rail into the lane and faltered late in the stretch run. BODENHEIMER pressed the pace early, was in the four path into the lane, lost action near the sixteenth pole and weakened late in the drive. PETIT VERDOT stalked the pace early, was in the six path into the lane and weakened late in the stretch drive. PERFECT MISTAKE was never a threat. BOSS BEAR was bumped at the start and done early. BAYTOWN BEAR lost his footing at the start and was through after a half. SCORSESE broke out at the start and trailed the field throughout.
