More than strictly distance-limited 1 **LADY WORTHINGTON** looks like a filly who performs better when she can establish a clear early lead. Think that can happen here with an alert break from the rail, and since she won over 6f at BEL and nearly stayed a mile two winters ago at GP in a race won by the good filly Cafe Americano, maybe she can see out this 6.5f trip. Speed-figure wise. 9 **ORIGINATOR** never has run better than when she was sixth in a KD stakes race last summer, her lone start over the course. She appears to have plateaued but perhaps the suitability to the irregular racing conditions can help her contend in a muddle of a field. 12 **YES IT'S GINGER** despite moving up a notch in class was 3-10 last out at Ellis, which says something about the competition, but she's two for two since the long layoff, could get a good clean pressing trip, and as a 4yo with seven starts easily could still have upside.
