SECOND OF JULY made light contact with AFTER FIVE in the shadow of the starting gate, trekked inward, what with the gate placed well off the inside, got briefly placed along the inside route, abandoned it, choosing the two path as the way to go during the run around the bend instead, was forced to idle behind some traffic from late on the bend until the vicinity of the three-sixteenths marker, angled to the outside, eventually attaining optimal racing clearance in path four in midstretch, took off in earnest after the ones to catch, struck the front end, rallying with good energy, in the final seventy yards and edged away. AFTER FIVE pursued the pace from path two after coming out slightly and brushing the winner at the start, fanned out six wide from upper to midlane, becoming the widest of all, had a good finish down the center of the course to garner the place. MOMOS grabbed the advantage, got guided over to the inside route, showed the way, with GYPSY KING in accompaniment one path farther off the rail, was coming up to the three-sixteenths pole when called upon for more, emerged a sixteenth down the road, clutching the lead by a slim margin but with several others bearing down menacingly from the outside, relinquished reluctantly with slightly less than a sixteenth to go, ventured onward with enough willingness to salvage the show. COUNTY FINAL took up residence in midpack travelling on the backstretch, sat within range of the front runners racing in the two path on the turn, got cued up moving to the outside as the second split was about to be posted, straightened away in path three, clawed his way into contention, displayed some run to the end, but came up short today. GYPSY KING one of the quickest out of the gate, remained forwardly placed, sparred for command from path two, got set down heading onto the top of the stretch, kept up its quest for another furlong before weakening. TRADE DEAL stalked the pace during the initial stages from off the inside, dove into the pocket approaching the conclusion of the backstretch, was patiently ridden keeping an eye on the front runners, went towards path two stepping onto the top of the lane, began a desperate search for a clear seam while inching its way to the outside, espied one fleetingly available in the neighborhood of path four in midstretch only to have to check, lacking the time to get maneuvered into it, continued to idle along the remainder of the journey home, having never been fully in the clear. BRIGHT DEVIL (IRE) three wide onto the turn, got steered into the five path exiting it, had no response.
