Footnotes

SO HIGH (GB) tracked the pace along the inside coming under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, spun three wide into upper stretch, bumped with MALTHAEL straightened away, dug in under a drive between foes through the final furlong taking narrow command a sixteenth from home and prevailed gamely on the wire. MALTHAEL saved ground in pursuit from mid pack, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, angled four wide into upper stretch, got bumped by the aforementioned foe straightened away, dug in under a drive heads apart for command inside the final furlong placing SO HIGH in a bit tight between rivals, fought on game to the finish but was ultimately denied on the wire. DREAM FRIEND coaxed from the gate, outsprinted TURN OF EVENTS for the front and forced that rival to concede midway on the first turn, showed the way in hand along the inside, remained patiently handled until roused cutting the corner into upper stretch, dug in under threat from a pair and clung to command to the sixteenth marker when displaced, fought on inside that pair to the finish clear for the show honors. VOTING CONTROL saved ground in pursuit from near the rear of the field, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, angled five wide

into upper stretch and offered up a mild kick to close in in the late stages. KID MERCURY saved ground near the rear of the field, came under coaxing at the three-eighths, cut the corner into upper stretch and offered up a mild kick to close belatedly to the finish. TURN OF EVENTS hustled from the gate, knocked heads early on with DREAM FRIEND into the first turn before being eased off to concede the front midway on that turn taking to the two path, tracked the leader in closest aim, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, spun just off the inside for home, dug in under a drive prominent to the eighth pole before weakening in the late stages. IMPAZIBLE ODDS three wide through the first turn, chased three to four wide under coaxing from the three-eighths, angled five wide into upper stretch and offered no response. SCORESWHENHEWANTS broke in brushing the near side stall at the start, then brushed with ARITHMETIC, chased just off the inside under a ride from three furlongs out, spun just off the inside for home and tired. LETTERMAN three wide through the first turn, chased three to four wide under coaxing from the three-eighths, angled five to six wide for home and tired. ARITHMETIC got brushed at the start by SCORESWHENHEWANTS who broke inwards, chased three to four wide, went six to seven wide into upper stretch and was eased through to the finish.
