Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of a sweepstakes allowed, 2 lbs.; a race other than maiden, claiming or starter, 4 lbs. The field will be limited to fourteen starters. If more than fourteen (14) entries pass the entry box preference will be given to those with the highest earnings. For Two Year Olds Under International Medication Protocol. Horses Nominated Or Entered To Compete Shall Not Be Eligible To Receive Furosemide Less Than Twenty-four (24) Hours Prior To Post Time For The Race. Trophy to winning owner. Closed Saturday, October 10, 2020 with 21 nominations.

Footnotes

COACH prompted the pace three wide while perched outside of a pair of foes, vied outside of those rivals around the far turn before drawing off turning for home, met LADY TRAVELER's bid in upper stretch, held tenaciously to repel that foe approaching the sixteenth pole, and won going away. LADY TRAVELER tracked from midpack in the three to two path, then inched closer in the four path around the far turn to produce a mild bid outside of COACH in upper stretch, but was turned away by that foe passing the sixteenth pole, and proved second best. OLIVIAOFTHEDESERT saved ground off of the pace around the first turn, advanced inside of foes down the backstretch to stalk from the pocket into the far turn, shifted two wide to pass the tiring early pace setter at the five sixteenths pole, but failed to keep pace with the leaders in upper stretch, then held show while chasing those foes home. DASH TO THE TOP bobbled and bumped a foe at the start, saved ground far off of the pace around the first turn, then from the three to five path around the far turn, but chased the leaders through the lane without producing a bid. MIDNIGHT BALLERINA trailed the field in four path around the first turn, rallied inside of a rival around the far turn before swinging five wide turning for home, but leveled off before menacing. TORSIE'S CHARM raced far off of the pace in the three to four paths around the turns, got fanned six wide turning for home, and failed to factor. ORSETTO stalked along the inside, but weakened around the far turn. MALIBU BIRD dueled for the lead along the inside around the first turn, held a margin down the backstretch, but was headed by foes passing the three furlong pole, weakened turning for home, and was eased through the lane. SALTY AS CAN BE dueled for the lead two wide before pressing the pace setter down the backstretch, vied between horses into the far turn, but proved no match for an outer rival turning for home, and weakened.
