KING FURY tracked from midpack in the three path, inched closer outside of the pair of foes into the far turn to make a three wide bid for the lead at the five sixteenths pole forged an advantage outside of SUPER STOCK approaching the furlong pole, and held firm to the wire as that foe battled on. SUPER STOCK stalked two wide, bid for the lead into the far turn, vied between horses turning for home as KING FURY ranged up alongside, but was headed by that foe in upper stretch, then battled on gamely to the wire, but failed to regain even terms. ONCOMING TRAIN stalked along the inside, chased the leaders under coaxing around the far turn, then stayed on through the lane while inside of ARABIAN PRINCE, and prevailed over that foe for show. ARABIAN PRINCE trailed the field two wide around the first turn, then three wide around the far turn but chased the leaders through the lane and failed to menace. FRANZ JOSEF tugged his was to a clear advantage early on, then clung to the lead inside of a pair of foes around the far turn, but proved no match for those rivals passing the quarter pole, and gave way through the final furlong. CRIME SPREE saved ground off of the pace while keen around the first turn, but got rank passing the six furlong pole, and was outrun thereafter.
