Footnotes

TELEPHONE TALKER prompted the pace setter from the outside, vied two wide around the far turn, forged an advantage passing the quarter pole, drew clear in midstretch, then flopped back to his left lead passing the sixteenth pole, and held. ATTORNEY TIM saved ground off of the pace around the first turn, then took the far turn three to four wide before tipping six wide turning for home, but produced a rally, surged in the final furlong to produce a bid approaching the wire, but missed. WINNING IMPRESSION bumped an inner foe and was jostled at the start, saved ground far off of the pace, tipped off of the rail at the quarter pole, but was blocked behind horses in upper stretch, shifted in and rallied through the final furlong, but did not have enough to catch the leaders, then took a bad step after the wire, broke down into the clubhouse turn, then was vanned off. CHURN N BURN broke outwardly, tracked from midpack in the four to three paths around the turns, then chased the leaders through the lane before getting outkicked by an inner and an outer foe at the sixteenth pole. LAKE NAKURU raced off of the pace three wide, four to five wide around the far turn, then chased between horses through the lane. MUD PIE was wiped out by an outer foe at the start, raced far off of the pace, took the far turn four to five wide before being floated seven wide turning for home,

then failed to factor. KING THEO lied forwardly placed two wide around the turns, then chased the leaders three wide through midstretch before weakening late. TOMA TODO set the pace along the inside, but was headed at the quarter pole, then faltered through the final furlong. PERJURY TRAP settled off of the pace two wide, three to four wide around the far turn, but bumped with, and was outkicked by, his outer counterpart turning for home, then faded thereafter. PARKLAND stalked along the inside, but was done at the three furlong pole, and stopped.
