**Footnotes**

KEEPMEINMIND patiently trailed the field around both turns, tipped five wide passing the quarter pole to set up shop outside of the leading group, then sustained a grinding charge, bid for the lead inside the final furlong, and got up approaching the wire. SMILEY SOBOTKA dueled for the lead along the inside of a pair of foes through the early part of the backstretch, got headed by those rivals around the far turn, but regained an advantage turning for home, repelled his outer counterparts passing the quarter pole, shook free in upper stretch, held a clear margin through midstretch, but was worn down by an oncharging foe in the late stages. ARABIAN PRINCE tracked from off of the pace two wide and between horses, chased from behind the leaders through upper stretch, then split foes four wide at the furlong pole while getting outkicked by the eventual winner, then kept on to secure show. SWILL stalked along the inside, shifted to the two path into the backstretch while still stalking the leading trio, tipped to the four path at the five sixteenths pole to be outside of those foes, attempted a bid in upper stretch, but was outkicked by an inner and an outer foe passing the furlong pole. KING FURY prompted the pace three wide, inched closer into the backstretch to bid for the lead, sustained vying position through the far turn, but failed to keep pace between horses in upper stretch, and weakened through the final furlong. SITTING ON GO saved ground off of the pace, and produced a mild rail rally through the lane, but failed to threaten. ONCOMING TRAIN dueled for the lead two wide and between horses, but weakened passing the quarter pole. ULTIMATE BADGER raced off of the pace three wide around both turns, and weakened. INSPECTOR FROST lied forwardly placed two wide, got rank between horses around the first turn, remained pulling in the bit shifting three wide down the backstretch, then faded while getting floated to the five path, then six path, turning for home.
