CROSSWORD sped to the front, set pace from along the rail, resisted when challenged late on the turn, re-established short advantage from the inside in mid-stretch, inched away under right handed urging and safely held. THAT COREY close up early while three wide, moved up and challenged three abreast leaving the bend, battled outside in upper stretch but was turned back by the winner. GORDY'S BOY had good early foot, forced the pace outside leader, bid between rivals passing quarter pole and well into the stretch but weakened later in the drive. THELUTEISMINE reserved off the early pace, chased two wide or between foes, came three wide into the stretch and went willingly to the wire. BUKAYO stalked from off the rail then three wide on the turn and failed to make any late impact. PEDRO PEREZ chased from the inside, remained along the rail and lacked needed response. HARD METAL chased early from the outside then three wide, angled over on the turn, shifted back out in the stretch and failed to menace. GABBY HAYES dwelt at the start, dropped far back in the early stages and never recovered while saving ground. THE STEWARDS CONDUCTED AN INQUIRY INVOLVING THE START BUT RULED THAT THE STARTING GATE OPENED PROPERLY GABBY HAYES CAUSED HIS OWN PROBLEM.
