4 POSITIVITY, who entered the G2 Los Alamitos Futurity on Saturday, can turn the tables on **8 GOOD WITH PEOPLE** in this mile stakes for Cal-bred 2yos. They finished second and first last out in a seven-furlong sprint stakes, but the margin between the two was less than a length, and the runner-up ran every bit as well as the winner. POSITIVITY was making his first start in three months when he popped the gate and was wrangled off the pace. While the winner coasted on the lead, POSITIVITY was rated, finished well and galloped out in front of the field. He ran like a horse that can improve with a race under his belt, and like he will appreciate two turns. Tab on the stretch out. GOOD WITH PEOPLE won three of four on dirt including a pair of Cal-bred sprint stakes. Not sure how far he wants to run, but he is likely to set the pace again and could get brave. **6 MISTER BOLD** won both starts including a highly rated sprint last out with the highest number (74 Beyer) in the field. Like most in the field, two turns might be a challenge for MISTER BOLD. An upset candidate is also-eligible MOVING FASTER, maiden turf route winner last out. Each start is better than the start before, there is no doubt about his ability to stay a distance.
