1 **NOT THAT BRADY** forms a strong entry with his stablemate Yankee Division. Would prefer to get him alone as he returns for just his second start of the year, following a run back in June where he contested a fast pace over a very sloppy track; has some questions surrounding him, but he has run some legitimately good races and may simply be too good for a field like this one. 2 **SIX PERCENT** showed some potential early on before losing his way a bit, and he has been back in form recently, with the return to shorter, one-turn races working to his advantage; good effort last time when just missing with a game late rally. 5 **CHESTERTOWN** still holding upside for top connections and getting significant class relief for this after failing to impact the Empire Classic; still looks like a work in progress but expecting him to turn out to be pretty good as an older horse
