Runner-up by a neck and a nose both recent starts, **8 THIS TEA** figures as the favorite in this turf mile for maiden fillies and mares. A mile and a quarter was slightly out of reach for 'TEA last out, though she ran well. She is the logical choice to win rallying from midpack. **3 ENGLAND'S ROSE** ran better than the line looks in her debut in August. Void of speed in the dirt sprint, she finished well and galloped out big past the wire. she is bred top and bottom for two turns on turf. European import **9 YA BEAUTY** is believed to be a better filly than her two starts here in summer suggest. Freshened two and a half months, look for her to rally late. Her trainer-jockey combo is 8-for-16 in maiden turf routes the past two+ years. SHES'A PERFECTLADY stretches out from a pair of sprints. Her running style suggests two turns will be her deal.
