After back-to-back troubled trips, **6 ENGLAND'S ROSE** switches riders to Umberto Rispoli and meets a modest field of maiden turf fillies and mares. 'ROSE broke slowly both starts; her most recent start was impressive. She walked out of the gate, trailed the field, unleashed a ground-saving rally through the far turn, hit traffic at the head of the lane and had to alter course, and finished with run. Beaten more than seven lengths, she might have been best. If she breaks with the field, she should be tough. **7 DISAPPEARING ACT** tossed in a clunker last time, but two previous starts in August and September, fifth and second, are as good as any of these have run. **8 WIND AND HOPE** finished in the top four her last three starts. That is not much of an endorsement, but enough to give her a look against a soft bunch.
