BOREAS took over around the first turn and moved inside, rated along to the stretch, and responded to pressure to remain in command. GROUP HUG raced two to three wide throughout, finished one-paced and got the place between horses. Q F SEVENTY FIVE advanced mildly into the stretch three wide, bumped with TOUR OF DUTY a furlong out, and lacked a solid final response. SARATOGA FLASH raced close up inside to the stretch, and was outfinished. EL KABONG unseated the rider and ran off prior to the start, was apprehended and came away without further incident, saved ground advancing after six furlongs, and flattened out late on the rail. TOUR OF DUTY saved ground in midpack to the far turn, moved off the rail bumping Q F SEVENTY FIVE in mid stretch, and had no punch. NEOTROPIC broke two lengths slowly, and was never prominent. JERRY'S TURN prompted the pace outside BOREAS for six furlongs, and tired. LORD OF WAR raced in range three to four wide to the top of the stretch, and tired. GOLDEN WHIM broke two lengths slow, raced three to four wide, and was through before reaching the stretch. THIS RACE WAS HAND TIMED, FRACTIONS UNAVAILABLE.
