Based on her highly rated runner-up debut, **2** **BYE BYE MISS PIE** should be heavily favored in this special-weight sprint. 'PIE was not quick from the gate first out, but recovered to make the lead after the first furlong, set a solid pace and finished more than three lengths clear of third with an 86 Beyer. That figure would win most races at this level. Her inside post (2 of 7) is a potential challenge considering she was not quick from the gate first out, but she can compensate on raw ability. The last 10 dirt-sprint favorites trained by Mike Puype produced five wins and five seconds. **3** **REEM** returns from a layoff of nearly a year, with a string of fast works. She faced good company including subsequent G1 winner Gamine last winter. Her works suggest she is ready to rip first start back. **7** **ANGEL OF FREEDOM** also faced good company her only start in autumn, third behind next-out winners Himiko and As Time Goes By. This is her first start in nearly four months, expect her to be rallying late. **FIERCE FOR SUL** adds speed.
