Footnotes

CELLIST vied outside of SPOTTERS HILL (IRE) while allowing that foe to show the way, inched closer around the far turn to spark a duel turning for home, battled through midstretch while forging a narrow advantage, then edged away from that rival in the final sixteenth. SPOTTERS HILL (IRE) set the pace while feeling pressure from CELLIST off of his outer flank dug in turning for home as that foe produced bid, duelled through midstretch, but was bested at the sixteenth marker, gave way late, and just held place. SOUTHERN DISTRICT saved ground from midpack, smoothly shifted three wide in upper stretch to pursue the dueling leaders, then chased those foes well through the lane while narrowing their margin, but missed reaching the early pace setter for place. CAMBI LION tracked from midpack two to three wide around the turns, got floated four wide turning for home, then five wide in upper stretch, but was outkicked by SOUTHERN DISTRICT in midstretch for minor rewards, chased thereafter, and just held fourth from an inner rallying rival. AVENUE leaned inwards and bumped the gate, then an inner foe at the start, rated far off of the pace two wide around the turns, then stayed on well to gain ground between horses through the lane, but missed a minor placing. FEEDING FRENZY stalked along the inside, but came under driving pressure into the far turn, sustained chasing position in upper stretch, but faded through the final furlong. WARN lied off of the pace two to three wide around the turns, shifted six wide turning for home, but lacked a rally. GINSBURNED was bumped by an outer foe into an inner foe at the start, then saved ground off of the pace, but to no avail. CARROBIO trailed the field, took the far turn three wide before swinging seven wide in upper stretch, but made little impact. STATEN ISLAND

stalked two wide, but was outkicked by an inner foe and an outer rival in upper stretch, and subsequently weakened. AGENT CREED was off slowly and bumped by an outer foe at the start, then saved ground at the rear of the field, and was outrun.
