

CLOSER LOOK: Was the top 3yo turf horse early last year after wins in the Cutler Bay, Pennine Ridge, and Hall of Fame; he didn't improve through the second half of 2020 and wound up falling short in his final three starts as his contemporaries caught up with him; he is talented and this is likely his preferred distance, though he no longer has the air of superiority around him after odds-on losses in the Saratoga Derby and Hill Prince; good spot for him to start back but far from a stand out at a short price.
