MO FAITH tracked the leaders near the inside for six furlongs, bid between horses past the eighth-pole, and finished gamely to get up outside VOODOO ZIP near the wire. VOODOO ZIP tugged his way along under a stout hold outside BEAR ALLEY through the first half-mile, poked a head in front approaching the stretch, edged clear briefly through the furlong grounds, then yielded the lead in the closing yards. SMALL TALK raced in striking range two to three wide for six furlongs, and finished with good courage outside the top two. ABSAM got sandwiched between DERBY DATE and THIRSTY OWL shortly after the start, advanced three then four wide around the far turn, and could gain only mildly through the lane. BEAR ALLEY set the pace inside for nearly six furlongs, and weakened through the stretch. TIMEFORAWOODFORD was moving his head around at the break and came out two lengths or so behind the others, and never reached contention. DERBY DATE came out, bumped with ABSAM and steadied soon after the start, and was never prominent. LIAM'S BOY raced three wide and tired before reaching the stretch. THIRSTY OWL bumped solidly with ABSAM after the start, and was outrun.
