**2 SLUMBER PARTY** not only is a debut maiden winner jumping into a 3yo G2 stakes, she won on the lead at Gulfstream, which can make a horse look better than it is, and will be a short price in the Beaumont. I'll still side with her. This filly raced Jan. 24 and has been on a regular work pattern since; have to guess connections picked this spot out long ago. Also, that was more than a standard-issue front-running maiden tally; filly showed high-end speed & athleticism plus a professional approach, and was taken in hand after the outcome had been determined, the place horse returning with a smart GP MSW score of her own. And this: Trainer K Breen since 2016 has sent 10 horses to race at KEE and they're 3-2-3 with a \$3.15 ROI.

**3 FARSIGHTED** has a plus recent race, possibly slop enhanced, showing she has come back from a winter break following a useful 2yo campaign in good enough order. The KEE MSW romp does encourage and the field she beat last fall was not bad. **7 TWENTY CARAT**'s pedigree tilts dirt more than anything and it's conceivable she improves upon her sharp TP Tapeta form while ambitiously stepped up in class by Wesley Ward. MY GIRL RED might be ok but goodness gracious was that Sorrento a soft spot.
