**11 A LONGLONGTIMEAGO** sat behind a competitive pace before driving it down to win first time out back in January, and earned a solid 74 Beyer in the process; projects for perhaps a similar trip in this spot as he steps back out of the Damon Runyan, where he bumped into a sharp winner. **3 WINNERS**

**LAUGH** showed speed right from the gate in his career debut after taking some money, and he never gave that field a chance while ringing up a field-best 87 Beyer; was entered in a very tough spot for his second start and completely blew the break. **9 SCHOKOLADE** has caught wet tracks in both starts so far and has shown speed in those races, including a game debut win where he raced off early pressure to prevail; cuts back after failing to see out the mile last time.
