WINNERS LAUGH was hustled to the lead, showed the way down the backstretch with some company to his outside, inched clear in the two path on the turn, responded well when set down into upper stretch, came out a bit when put to a left-handed crop outside the furlong marker, switched to a left-handed crop in the final sixteenth and held under strong urging. DEVIL'S CODE was rated just off the pace while tugging hard at the bit, saved ground while drafting behind the leader on the turn, was asked inside the five-sixteenths, moved off the rail into upper stretch, chased under a right-handed crop while still on his inside lead to the eighth-pole, swapped to the proper lead at that point then was switched to a left-handed crop, pursued the winner in the final furlong and finished willingly for the place. BRILLIANT BROOKS settled in the front half of the field, started the turn in the two path then shifted four wide, was roused five wide into the stretch, chased the top two in the drive and lacked the needed kick while able to get the show. KAZ'S BEACH was bumped solidly on both sides after the start, settled off the pace, went around the turn in the two path, was roused at the quarter-pole and lacked the needed response. IT'S GRAVY

broke in and bumped with an opponent, settled on the far outside, was urged five then six wide on the turn and failed to threaten. ROYAL SUSPECT made solid contact with KAZ'S BEACH after the start, angled in at the rear, saved ground on the turn and was no factor. REGGAE MUSIC MAN bumped soundly with a rival after the start, settled off the pace, dropped back while three then four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and had nothing left. JACKS AMERICAN PIE was bumped soundly on both sides soon after the start, raced well back in the field, went three to four wide on the turn and never reached contention. A LONGLONGTIMEAGO was off slow and spotted the front a few lengths, raced well back on the outside, went five wide early on the turn then was carried seven wide, spun eight wide into the stretch and failed to respond. NINTH HOUR settled under some urging, went four then five wide on the turn, came six wide into the stretch and also failed to respond. SCHOKOLADE stalked the pace on the outside then in the three path on the turn, was asked late on that bend, chased into upper stretch and capitulated. LEAP TO GLORY broke through the front of the gate prior the start then was urged some by his rider before realizing the rest of the field had yet to be dispatched, was caught by the outrider after going over a sixteenth from the gate then brought back around and reloaded, came away in good order, settled in the front half of the field, was urged four then five wide on the turn, dropped back at the five-sixteenths and faltered then was eased in the final furlong but walked off.
