Footnotes

BEAR ALLEY cleared off early on, managed that clear lead while well in hand, was let out approaching the three sixteenths pole as a pair of rivals attempted to range up alongside, but swiftly shrugged those rivals off at the furlong pole, and held well to the wire. BAMALAMA stalked the clear leader two wide, came under a drive at the three furlong pole to inch closer, did so entering the lane and produced a mild bid, but was turned away at the furlong pole, and proved second best. COOL RAGS tracked from midpack along the inside, advanced to a stalking position into the backstretch, tracked the leader around the far turn before swinging three wide entering the lane to attempt a bid, but only managed to chase through upper stretch, flopped back to his left lead at the furlong marker, weakened thereafter, but just saved show. SPHEROID lied far off of the pace along the inside, and improved through the lane to just miss catching COOL RAGS for show. NIANGUA lagged well behind the field around both turns, and improved through the lane without factoring. BOLD MINISTER saved ground from midpack, but faded around the turn. SOMETIMES ALWAYS lied forwardly placed three wide, but was done early.
