DREAMS OF TOMORROW broke through the front of the gate prior to the start but remained in the stall, was unhurried at the rear of the field, went three then four wide on the turn, rallied while roused into the stretch, closed fast to get the lead at the three-sixteenths then drew away under steady urging. RED STORM RISEN was reserved off the pace, went around most of the turn in the three path, dropped to the two path outside the quarter-pole and impeded foes then was asked, chased into upper stretch, moved out under a drive into the final furlong and earned the place while no match for the winner. VOODOO ZIP was taken in hand early then rated in third position, became keen while tugging hard at the bit outside the five-eighths then was shuffled back behind ARHAM as that foe was taken back off the pace, saved ground on the turn, checked behind ARHAM again when that foe also checked outside the quarter-pole, angled out while put to a drive in upper stretch and got up for the show. LONESOME FUGITIVE (IRE) bumped with a rival at the start, was reserved off the pace, went two then three wide on the turn, was roused at the quarter-pole then came under a drive in upper stretch and lacked the needed response. ARHAM jostled with a foe leaving the chute onto the main course, disputed the pace on the inside of a foe, was taken back off the pace at the five-eighths then dropped further back, came under urging in the two path on the turn, checked when RED STORM RISEN came inward in front outside the quarter-pole and capitulated. REJECTED AGAIN was asked leaving the gate, bumped with TIO MAGICO early, contested the pace on the outside, moved clear with five furlongs to run, controlled the action while inside to the two path on the turn, was given his cue at the quarter-pole, lost the advantage to the winner in upper stretch and tired. TIO MAGICO was asked departing the gate, bumped with REJECTED AGAIN early then checked, became very keen under stout restraint, went four wide while let out on the turn then was roused at the five-sixteenths and had nothing left.
