DETERMINED FURY settled towards the front on the outside, tucked into the two to three path on the turn, was roused four wide into the stretch, rallied on the outside, closed strongly to get the lead approaching the sixteenth-pole and prevailed under strong handling. RUN SMITTY RUN was hustled from the

start then taken in hand and rated off the pace, went three to four wide on the turn, was put to a drive in upper stretch and finished willingly for the place. CONGRATS FOR GLORY showed excellent speed, disputed the pace on the outside of a foe, vied in the two to three path on the turn, shook clear inside the three-eighths, was asked for his best in upper stretch, led until near the sixteenth-pole then was overtaken while just able to save the show. RAISING SAND bumped with a foe at the start, settled off the pace, saved ground on the turn, came out while put to a drive into upper stretch and also finished willingly then just missed the show. CAMOUFLAGED KISSER broke out at the start, stalked the leading duo on the outside, tucked into the two to three path on the turn, was put to a drive into upper stretch, chased into the final furlong and weakened. UNCLE MO'S CAT bumped with an opponent at the start then was taken up early, saved ground on the turn, moved out near the furlong marker and improved position without threatening. LOADED JOE made contact with a rival at the start, contested the pace on the inside of a foe, vied along the rail on the turn, dropped back outside the five-sixteenths and capitulated. HASTY TOURIST was off slow and spotted the front a few lengths, settled towards the rear, went four wide on the turn and failed to threaten. BECKENBAUER was taken up at the start, settled towards the rear, went five wide on the turn and lacked the needed response. VENERABLE settled on the far outside, went four wide on the turn and failed to rally. BIG CITY DREAMS checked behind KENTUCKY KNIGHT early as that foe lost action in front of him, saved ground while well back through the turn and was no factor then protected by the rider in the final furlong. KENTUCKY KNIGHT bumped with an opponent at the start, lost action early while slipping a bit behind then was taken up sharply, dropped well behind the rest of the field and was eased but walked off.
