BEAR ALLEY cleared early on, loped along with low head carriage into the first turn, felt pressure from CLAYNTHELIONHEART into the far turn before meeting the foe's bid entering the lane, resisted that foe gamely through the lane, and held tenaciously to the wire. CLAYNTHELIONHEART stalked the clear leader from the two path around the first turn, pressed that foe into the far turn, sparked a duel by bidding entering the lane, subtly drifted out from left handed pressure through upper stretch, but sustained the battle while drifting back inwards from right handed pressure inside the final furlong, but was denied. SOUTHERN PASSAGE rated at the rear of the field two wide, shifted five wide turning for home, and sustained a mild rally through the lane to close the gap on the dueling leaders late. DACK JANIEL'S shifted to the three path into the first turn while tracking from midpack, but came under a drive to keep pace with tucking to the rail into the far turn, and chased through the lane. MONEY FOR MISCHIEF lied far off of the pace three to four wide, and failed to factor. CANCELLARA saved ground at the rear of the field, but to no avail. TURNAGAIN TIDE tracked from midpack four wide around the first turn, chased the leading duo three wide around the far turn, and weakened.
