NECKER ISLAND raced back early on, was in the three path along the turn, off the rail into the lane, rallied down the lane from the rail, under a long drive in the final stages and prevailed at the wire. GUN IT stalked the pace early, raced in the three path along the turn, was in the five path into the lane, inched clear near the eighth pole, was under a long drive in the final stages and caught nearing the wire. TAISHAN chased the pace early on, was in the four path into the lane, made a bid in the stretch but hung in the late stages. BEAVER HAT raced back early on, raced in the four path along the turn, was in the six

path entering the lane, made a bid down the lane but flattened out late in the drive. SAVVY was unhurried early on, raced in the three path into the lane and moved up late in the stretch run. OAK HILL steadied along the backstretch from the rail and again nearing the lane, stayed on the inside into the lane and weakened late in the stretch. RELENTLESS DANCER set the pace early, was off the rail into the lane and gave way late in the stretch drive. AMERICAN BUTTERFLY was checked repeatedly along the backstretch while between horses. PIT BOSS was never a threat. GLORY ROAD was through after a half. BEAR ALLEY had early speed then was pulled up in the stretch and walked off after the race.
