FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS. Non-Lasix Race pursuant to 4043.2 (7)(e)(5) Lasix not permitted within 48 hours of post time. By subscription of \$250 each which should accompany the nomination; \$1,250 to pass the entry box and an additional \$1,250 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$2,500 (along with the entry and starting fees) may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 55% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 12% to third, 6% to fourth, 4% to fifth and 3% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weight 124 lbs. Non-winners of a Graded Sweepstake at a mile or over allowed 2 lbs.; of a Sweepstake allowed 4 lbs.; of two races other than maiden, claiming, starter or state-bred allowance in 2021 allowed 6 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, June 19, 2021 with 16 Nominations.

Footnotes

FIRST CAPTAIN dropped back early then settled towards the rear, was urged along while moving from the two path to the four path on the turn, rallied outside to make a bid under a left-handed crop outside the furlong marker then took the advantage just inside that marker, disposed of the runner-up into the final sixteenth and moved clear under a hand ride to prove best. RIDIN WITH BIDEN went clear early, set the an uncontested pace through sensible fractions while in hand, controlled the action while inside through the turn, was asked at the quarter-pole then came under a drive in upper stretch, lost the advantage while drifting just inside the furlong marker and was outfinished while able to hold the place. SNOW HOUSE settled comfortably on the outside, went three wide on the turn, was given his cue at the five-sixteenths, chased under a drive into the final furlong, moved out outside the sixteenth-pole and was out-kicked while well clear for third. GERSHWIN tracked the pace under coaxing, chased in the two path on the turn, passed the five-sixteenths under a strong hand ride, was put to the crop outside the quarter-pole and came up empty. CIVIL WAR settled on the outside, was roused four wide on the turn, dropped back under the crop while three wide into the stretch and failed to respond.
