VOODOO ZIP four paths off the inside down the backstretch in pursuit from mid pack, tucked to the two path into the turn and was patiently handled until placed to coaxing near the quarter pole, spun just off the inside for home set down for the drive, rallied to issue a challenge a furlong from home, got herded out three paths as YES AND YES came out under the use of a near side crop and gamely took command seventy yards from home digging in to inch away late and prevail. YES AND YES broke out a step at the start bumping and pinching SUPPLY AND DEMAND and RIVER TIBER against pressure outside from BIG PACKAGE, led early on before settling four wide in aim of the leader down the backstretch, tucked three then two wide through the turn advancing to take command just outside the quarter pole, took the inside route into upper stretch, dug in under threat coming out to look his main danger in the eye nearing the eighth pole then drifted out under use of a near side crop herding the aforementioned foe out three paths to the sixteenth marker, got caught seventy yards from home and fought on to the finish latched on and well clear of the rest. BIG PACKAGE broke in a step at the start bumping and pinching RIVER TIBER and SUPPLY AND DEMAND against pressure from YES AND YES, who broke outwards a step to their inside, chased three then two wide under coaxing from the three-eighths, spun three wide into upper stretch and kicked on belatedly to secure the show honors. SUPPLY AND DEMAND bumped between foes at the start, chased two to three wide until tucked inside through the turn, came under coaxing at the three-eighths, spun just off the inside for home and improved position through to the finish. TIBERIUS MERCURIUS five then four wide in pursuit in range of the leader, got coaxed along three furlongs from home, spun three wide into upper stretch and weakened in the late stages. AFTER FIVE brushed the off side stall at the start, chased six paths off the inside down the backstretch and then three wide through the turn under coaxing from the three-eighths, angled four to five wide into upper

stretch and weakened. AMPERSAND brushed the near side stall at the start and got away slowly, chased three to four wide down the backstretch and then just off the inside through the turn, went five wide for home and offered no response. ANANROAD forwardly placed from the start under coaxing, established command five and a half furlongs from home and showed the way in hand just off the inside, tucked to the inside inside the three-eighths and came under coaxing with five-sixteenths to go, yielded the front near the quarter pole, cut the corner into upper stretch in retreat and tired in the drive. RIVER TIBER got bumped between rivals at the start, chased two to three wide until tucked inside half a mile from home, came under coaxing at the three-eighths, took the inside route into upper stretch and tired. SPARKLING SKY chased two to three wide down the backstretch and then four to five wide through the turn, went five wide for home and trailed.
