Very nice 3yo handicap, with the strength of the group seemingly coming from Kentucky. **4 HE'S IN CHARGE**'s ceiling is pretty darn high, if you consider that Tulane Tryst is a pretty talented 3yo one-turn dirt horse and HIC whipped him in January. Blameworthy, who beat him in the first allowance start, was very fast over 6f on dirt this winter and spring, CIS might not have loved a wet track two back, and he lost his chance last out at the start. Trainer A Stall has taken a typically patient approach here, and think this colt can get seven furlongs, especially if he made the lead and switched off. **7 THERIDEOFALIFETIME** had strong 2yo form through Jackie's Warrior but only started coming around again his last two. On the one hand he got a great setup winning last time at CD, but on the other he stands to pull another favorable trip from this cozy outside draw. **3 SHADOW MATTER** beat Theride when they met in KY and still has upside, but will need to work out a trip drawn inside other serious speed.
