3 **COINAGE** lacked early speed and then raced a bit greenly while closest at the finish in his debut going five; took a nice step forward last time while ridden out to an easy score at a short price and he is bred to continue to get better for a trainer who brings them along with racing. 2 **BARESE** was well-meant for his debut back in May and gamely prevailed at the end while going favored over the top one; shows a month-long gap in his works after that race but he ran well that day to get to the speedy runnerup at the end and Irad sticks. 5 **READY A. P.** a filly entered vs. the boys following an eye-catching, if slow, debut win three weeks ago; lost ground at the start after failing to break sharply from the gate that day, but she fairly cruised past that field on the turn, before running away in the stretch; moves outside.
