**Footnotes**

THE LIR JET (IRE) was forwardly placed along the inside, got through entering the stretch, struck the front near the furlong marker and edged clear. EASY TIME was under a snug hold just off of the inside, moved with the winner into the stretch, slipped through and was making up ground. FAUCI contended on the outside, came six wide, churned on but found his best stride too late. INTO THE SUNRISE was away alertly, set the pressured pace just off of the inside, was collared between horses into the stretch and grudgingly gave in. MISS AMULET (IRE) settled between rivals, steadied from tight quarters near the three furlong marker, leveled back into stride and improved position between foes. COUNTY FINAL pulled to contention toward the inside, shifted out and loomed large between rivals entering the stretch, but wilted in the drive and faded. POINT ME BY was allowed to settle, came six wide to make a mild bid but failed to sustain the drive. ANNEX was allowed to settle, angled out further to be clear but lacked the need response. BODENHEIMER vied for the lead outside to the stretch, but faltered between runners in the drive and retreated. OMAHA CITY was unhurried outside and failed to respond. NEXT was close up three wide to the stretch and dropped out.
