If you compare the Charles Town form to that produced at Laurel, you might come to the conclusion that **7 FIBER AND EMILY** prefers a standard larger oval to the small course at CT. He got back on a bigger course in his most recent start but ran for the first time on turf and apparently hated it. Throw that race out, and if the big-track theory holds and he approaches his best LRL performances, he can post an upset. Think that **2 GUILLAUME** will be all right cutting back from a one-turn mile to this 6.5-furlong trip - but not entirely certain. Did win debut going 5.5f last season at CNL, albeit in VA-restricted competition. And speaking of cutbacks, **1 ARABIAN PRINCE**, who races on Lasix for the first time, never has sprinted. Obviously ran into some very tough horses in those stakes tries. Don't like the rail draw for him.
