**4 OFF WE GO** didn't appear to have a real excuse last time while down inside and not coming through in the stretch when she had room, though she was off the layoff there and the winner of that race has been on a strong run while winning 6 of her last 7 dirt starts; showed some potential early on and getting off the rail might benefit her as she makes her second start back. **5 LADY TRAVELER** broke her maiden sprinting early on and has made each of her five dirt starts since vs. stakes rivals - three of those going longer; cuts back and returns to her available condition following paired-up Beyer tops in her last two races. **1 SPIN A YARN** a NY-bred coming off of a successful 4yo debut at Finger Lakes as a very heavy favorite; has speed from the rail and will race with Lasix for the first time.
