GOLDEN PAL set the pace early from well off the rail, raced in the two path along the turn, was in the four path into the lane, was headed slightly near the three sixteenths pole, came back quickly and shot away from foes under a steady drive. EXTRAVAGANT KID chased the pace early, was briefly steadied nearing the five sixteenths pole, was in the four path into the lane, altered out further in the upper stretch and down the lane under a rally and was up for place in the final stages. COUNTY FINAL chased the pace early, raced in the three path along the turn, was in the five path into the lane, rallied late in the stretch and was gaining in the final stages. JOHNNY UNLEASHED stalked the pace early from the inside, shied from the rail nearing the five sixteenths pole, was in the two path into the lane and weakened late in the stretch run. INHALATION (GB) was a bit slow at the start and raced back early on, was on the inside along the turn, in the three path into the lane and moved up in the stretch drive. FIRECROW tracked the pace early, raced in the three path along the turn, was in the five path into the lane, stuck a nose in front near the three sixteenths pole but was repelled and faltered late in the drive. CHARCOAL trailed the field throughout.
