CONVERTIBLE FREEZE stumbled at the start but broke with the field, disputed the pace on the outside, vied in the three then two path on the turn, shook clear under a drive in upper stretch. drew off under strong urging into the final seventy yards then was placed under a hand-ride while much the best. DEVIOUS BANKER settled just off the pace, was taken in hand while just behind the leader at the seven-sixteenths, moved from the two path to the three

path on the turn, was asked at the five-sixteenths, chased the winner into upper stretch and proved no match while able to get the place. REGAL EMPIRE was ridden along on the outside, moved further out late on the backstretch, went five wide on the turn and got up for the show. WORKINGMAN'S DUDE bobbed slightly at the start, showed speed then pressed the pace, vied inside on the turn, dropped back under a drive in upper stretch and weakened then just missed the show. KONG LOVES A FIGHT broke a bit slow, settled at the rear, was urged five to six wide on the turn and failed to threaten. EMPIRE STATION settled off the pace, was urged four wide on the turn and failed to respond. EL VEINTICUATRO brushed with a foe while off a step slow, settled off the pace, was urged along passing the five-eighths, went three to four wide on the turn and was no factor. MRTANDROSEYSBOY veered in at the start, showed speed then chased the pace, dropped back outside the half-mile pole, went around the turn in the two path and came up empty. ALMOND CIDER lost his footing at the start, dropped back outside the half-mile pole then moved out, went three wide on the turn and had nothing left. VIBE SETTER was urged along off the pace, traveled around the turn in the two path and never reached contention. TIZ SNOW brushed with an opponent at the start then bobbed, saved ground on the turn and faltered.
