1 **HAPPY MEDIUM** ran well in his debut earlier this year before missing some time, then returned to dominate maidens in fast time in his second start; handled a wet track last time to win again as a heavy favorite; takes the next logical step looking like a short price once again. 6 **WUDDA U THINK NOW** holds an experience edge on the top one and exits a solid win off the layoff last time while contesting the pace from start to finish; has some other quality speed to deal with here but doesn't need the lead to be effective. 8 **CHESTERTOWN** cut back for the Hudson last time but caught a wet track for the fourth time on his last five starts and could only manage a distant second at a big price; last two wins both came over fast dirt, including a one-turn mile with a solid 88 Beyer and he should have some pace in front of him here.
