3 **LITTLE MENACE** started out sprinting with some success, then became a stakes winner routing at three; tried making the switch to turf early last year to no avail, but he returned to the main track to earn a new top figure when scoring decisively on a class drop last November; good effort last time when rushing up to contest the pace after a slow start; dangerous off the claim for Atras. 5 **CHESTERTOWN**'s four career wins have all come routing, including the Albany over state-breds at a 3yo; has landed in three straight tough spots since cutting back recently, including that last one when coming through on the rail at the top of the stretch, and he was still in contention when bumped several times and forced to take up coming to the furlong grounds; needs some pace. 1 **BUY LAND AND SEE** is a stakes winner on turf, and he earned a career-best 94 Beyer in his main track debut last time going a mile; not sure he ever got the advantage in the stretch as suggested by the short comment, but he still ran a solid race vs. a good field in that spot.
