

CLOSER LOOK: Earned the highest Beyer on the page (77) when second to the future two-time G3 winner Newgrange at first asking, but could only manage second as the heavy favorite most recently; his last race contained two next-out maiden special winners, and victorious Wharton subsequently finished a distant third behind a long-gone Messier in the G3 Lewis; son of the late/great Arrogate is a half-brother to G1-winning turf miler Heart to Heart; Prat is 2 for 8 at the meet for Sadler, who has respectable numbers going sprint/route.
